## SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

**The 2018-2019 Catholic Foundation of Oklahoma Scholarship Applications are now available.**

The Catholic Foundation offers a \$6,000 scholarship (\$1,500 per year) to students attending a non-Catholic college or university and a \$12,000 scholarship (\$3,000 per year) to students attending a Catholic college. Scholarships are renewable for up to four years as long as academic and enrollment guidelines are maintained.

**Guidelines for eligibility:**  Applicant must show scholastic ability and financial need.  Applicant must be a full-time, undergraduate student (Minimum of 12 enrolled hours per semester)  Applicant must be a registered, active member of a Catholic parish in the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City

All required information must be received by the Catholic Foundation office **NO LATER THAN Tuesday, APRIL 3, 2018**. PLEASE NOTE: Due to 2018 Holy Week schedule, **Pastor Recommendation Forms are due by Friday, March 16, 2018**
