Fast & Abstinence—Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onward.

Lenten Friday Evening Mass, Soup Supper and Stations of the Cross. Prayer is one of the three pillars of Lenten practice. Through prayer, we raise our hearts and minds to God in thanksgiving and praise. During Lent, we place special emphasis on prayer and contemplation of the Passion and Death of our Lord through expressions of popular piety such as the Stations of the Cross and veneration of the Crucified Christ. In order to encourage more people to participate in the Lenten Fridays, we will have the Friday Masses—only during Lent—at 6:00 p.m. in the Church, and immediately after the Mass we will have a soup supper served in the Parish Hall by parish organizations, followed by Stations of the Cross at 7:00
