Ordinary Time of the Liturgical Year:

The rhythm of the liturgical seasons reflects the rhythm of life, with its celebrations of Christmas and Easter and its seasons of quiet growth and maturing.

Ordinary Time of the liturgical year is celebrated in two segments: from the Monday following the Baptism of Our Lord up to Ash Wednesday; and from Pentecost Monday to the First Sunday of Advent. This makes it the largest season of the Liturgical Year.

There are thirty four Sundays of Ordinary Time culminating in the Solemnity of Christ the King, during which time the church inviting her children to meditate upon the whole mystery of Christ – his life, miracles and teachings – in the light of his Resurrection. The color of the vestment during the ordinary time is green which represents a sign of hope and growth.
