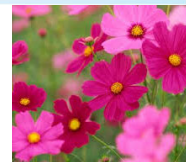

### *Most Christians on the globe belong to a Church that believes in the Real Presence.*

One reason so few people today believe what the Church teaches about the Eucharist is that the teaching is so shocking: After consecration, the host at Mass isn't bread; it is Jesus Christ himself. He just *looks* like bread. *Really?*

**Really!** Here's how the Catechism puts it: *"In the most blessed sacrament of the Eucharist 'the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ and, therefore, the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially contained.'"*

Jesus taught the doctrine most clearly in the sixth chapter of John: "Jesus said to them, **'Very truly I tell you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. ... For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink.'**"

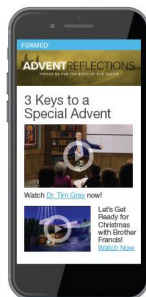
